

Prof. Stefano Pelaggi 簡介：

Stefano Pelaggi received a MA in Sociology and a Ph.D. in History both from the Sapienza University of Rome. He is currently aggregate professor in “Nationalism and national minorities in Europe” at Sapienza University and in the past years he has been teaching “Development and Processes of Colonization and Decolonization”. He conducts research activities at CEMAS in Sapienza University and in Geopolitica.info Studies Centre. His research field is mainly focused in the concept of soft power and public diplomacy. He has conducted several studies on the Italian colonial projection through migration flows, on the history of the promotion of Italian culture abroad and various analyzes of soft power models used by the different European states.

The object of the research for which was awarded the scholarship of the MOFA study focuses on the perception of the Taiwanese soft power and public diplomacy in Europe and particularly in Italy. He has published several books including “Il colonialismo popolare. L'emigrazione e la tentazione espansionistica italiana in America latina” and “L'altra Italia. Emigrazione storica e mobilità giovanile a confronto”, numerous articles in scientific journals and contributions in collective volumes. Over the years he has participated in various conferences and workshops, has been a visiting professor in many countries including Argentina and Myanmar and he has taught courses in various Italian universities.
